REPORT OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

Letter dated 26 June 1975 from the Permanent Representatives
of France, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern
Ireland and the United States of America to the United Nations
addressed to the Secretary-General

We have the honour to refer to the communication of 12 May 1975 of the Permanent Mission of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics (A/10084) concerning the United Nations <u>Demographic Yearbook</u>.

The Governments of France, the United Kingdom and the United States do not accept the assertions contained in the Soviet note about the legal status of Berlin and about the origin or nature of the rights of the four Powers. We therefore reaffirm the terms of the letter of 14 April 1975 (A/10078) in which the views of the three Governments are set out.

We request you to circulate this letter as a document of the General Assembly.
