ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 18 August 1975 from the President of the Security Council
to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the General Assembly the following resolution (resolution 374 (1975)) on the admission of the People's Republic of Mozambique to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 1838th meeting, on 18 August 1975:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of the People's Republic of Mozambique for admission to membership in the United Nations, 1/

"Recommends to the General Assembly that the People's Republic of Mozambique be admitted to membership in the United Nations."

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, I also request you to transmit to the General Assembly, for its information, the verbatim records of the 1837th and 1838th meetings of the Security Council, at which the application of the People's Republic of Mozambique was discussed.
