Note by the Secretary-General

Corrigendum

Page 1, paragraph 3

Replace the text by the following:

3. At its fifty-eighth session the Economic and Social Council undertook an examination of the activities undertaken or planned in connexion with the Decade, as contained in the Secretary-General's reports. The Council adopted resolutions 1938 A and B (LVIII) on 6 May 1975. In resolution 1938 A (LVIII), the Council took note with appreciation of the reports (E/5636 and Add.1-3, E/5637 and Add.1 and 2); requested the Secretary-General to submit those reports, together with a report containing information received by him on activities undertaken or contemplated in connexion with the Decade which would supplement the information on the subject submitted to the Economic and Social Council at its fifty-eighth session, and the summary records of the Council's discussion on the matter at its fifty-eighth session, (E/AC.7/SR.758-760 and 763-764 and E/SR.1948) to the General Assembly at its thirtieth session; welcomed the adoption by United Nations organs and bodies, as well as by the Committee on the Elimination of Racial Discrimination, the specialized agencies and intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations, of resolutions and/or measures related to the goals and objectives of the Decade; and recommended to the General Assembly the adoption of a draft resolution by which the Assembly would, inter alia, request the Secretary-General to submit to the General Assembly at its thirty-first session a report containing proposals to implement efficiently paragraph 17 of the Programme for the Decade which calls for the establishment of an international fund on a voluntary basis. In resolution 1938 B (LVIII), the Council

welcomed with appreciation the offer of the Government of Ghana to act as host to the world conference to combat racism and racial discrimination and recommended to the Assembly the adoption of a draft resolution. The draft resolutions recommended to the Assembly for adoption are reproduced in the annex to the present report.
