APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE UNITED NATIONS ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL

Resolution adopted by the General Assembly at its 324th plenary meeting on 14 December 1950

(adopted on the report of the Fifth Committee (A/1675))

The General Assembly

1. Appoints the following persons as members of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal:

The Right Honourable Lord Crook;

Dr. Vladimir Outrata;

Dr. Hamed Sultan;

2. <u>Declares</u> the Right Honourable Lord Crook and Dr. Vladimir Outrata to be appointed for a three-year term ending on 30 November 1953, and Dr. Hamed Sultan for a period ending on 30 November 1952.*

^{*} Article 1 of the rules adopted by the Administrative Tribunal on 7 June 1950 provides that:

[&]quot;Subject to any contrary decision of the General Assembly of the United Nations, the term of office of members of the Tribunal shall commence on the first day of December in the year of their appointment by the General Assembly".
