Report of the Fifth Committee

1. Under rule 154 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, and on the basis of reports by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/845) and the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/4622), the Fifth Committee, at its 813th meeting, considered the financial implications of the draft resolution (A/C.2/L.469/Rev.1) adopted by the Second Committee at its 686th meeting.

2. Following a discussion in which several members made observations on the importance of the subject dealt with in the draft resolution, the Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that the adoption of the draft resolution recommended by the Second Committee could give rise to additional costs of some \$28,500 in 1961 and \$19,500 in 1962.
