APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP
OF SUBSIDIARY BODIES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

BOARD OF AUDITORS

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. T.W. CUTTS (Australia)

1. At its 784th meeting, held on 4 November 1960, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/4379) concerning the vacancy which will occur in the membership of the Board of Auditors at the expiration of the term of office of one of its members on 30 June 1961.
2. The Chairman had previously invited members of the Fifth Committee to make suggestions with respect to the Auditor-General (or officer holding the equivalent title) who might be recommended to the General Assembly for appointment to membership in the Board of Auditors. At the time the matter was considered by the Committee, the Government of Pakistan had informed the Secretary-General that the Auditor-General of Pakistan would be available for appointment to the Board.
3. For the purpose of deciding who should be recommended for appointment, the Committee proceeded to vote by secret ballot. The result of the ballot was as follows:

The Auditor-General of one other Member State received one vote.

4. The Auditor-General of Pakistan, having obtained the required majority, was declared recommended for appointment.
5. The Committee wishes to record its gratitude to the Government of Norway for having placed at the disposal of the Organization during the past six years the services of its Auditor-General, and its appreciation of those services.

Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

6. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

The General Assembly

Appoints the Auditor-General of Pakistan as a member of the Board of Auditors for a three-year term to commence on 1 July 1961.
