

Seventy-second session First Committee

Allocation of agenda items to the First Committee

Note by the Secretariat

- 1. At the 2nd plenary meeting of its seventy-second session, held on 15 September 2017, the General Assembly took decisions pertaining to the allocation of agenda items (see A/72/252), including to the First Committee (see annex).

¹ At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 15 September 2017, the General Assembly decided to approve the recommendation contained in paragraph 106 (b) of the first report of the General Committee (A/72/250 and Corr.1), which reads:

⁽b) Item 99 (General and complete disarmament). The General Committee took note of the fact that some portions of the annual report of the International Atomic Energy Agency, which is to be considered directly in plenary meeting under item 89, dealt with the subject matter of item 99. The General Committee therefore decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the relevant paragraphs of the report be brought to the attention of the First Committee in connection with its consideration of item 99;

- (a) Treaty banning the production of fissile material for nuclear weapons or other nuclear explosive devices;
- (b) Nuclear disarmament;
- (c) Notification of nuclear tests;
- (d) Relationship between disarmament and development;
- (e) Prohibition of the dumping of radioactive wastes;

- (g) Conventional arms control at the regional and subregional levels;
