### Letter dated 12 September 2017 from the Permanent Representative of the Sudan to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have written several letters to the Security Council, the most recent of which was my letter of 17 July 2017 addressed to the Security Council ([S/2017/616](#)), regarding the Egyptian occupation of the Hala'ib triangle in the Sudan and its repercussions. In those letters, I described the measures taken by the Egyptian authorities to consolidate the occupation and impose facts on the ground that contravene international norms, instruments and provisions, including those related to international humanitarian law. I now wish to transmit herewith an updated report on the measures taken and violations committed recently by the Egyptian Government against Sudanese civilians in the occupied triangle. The Egyptian authorities have jailed or expelled civilians in a concerted attempt to Egyptianize the triangle, alter its demographic composition and consolidate the occupation (see annex).

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter and its annex circulated as a document of the Security Council.

**Annex to the letter dated 12 September 2017 from the Permanent Representative of the Sudan to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council**

**Violations committed recently by the Egyptian Government against Sudanese civilians in the Sudanese Hala'ib triangle (Hala'ib, Shalatin and Abu Ramad)**

The Egyptian authorities have carried out a campaign of searches and arrests in the three towns of the triangle (Hala'ib, Shalatin and Abu Ramad) and in the neighbouring areas along the border between the two countries. They have detained 222 Sudanese citizens living in the towns and villages of the triangle.

The detainees were taken to the prisons of Safaja, Ghardaqa and Marsa Alam in Red Sea governorate.

The arrests were made by various Egyptian military intelligence units in July and early August 2017, and particularly on 13, 22 and 26 July. Some detainees were taken individually, others in groups.

The civilians were detained on charges of rejecting the occupation and refusing to apply for identity documents. They were taken to prison. An attempt was made, in clear violation of international humanitarian law, to expel them from the areas where they have spent their entire lives.

The names of a number of civilians who were recently detained are set out below. Large numbers of them were expelled because they were found to have Sudanese passports. There are many others whose names we will provide you with in due course.
