In order to develop their relations on the basis of the principles of mutual respect for sovereignty, equality, territorial integrity, non-interference in each other's internal affairs, the peaceful settlement of disputes, and in accordance with the Purposes and Principles of the Charter of the United Nations, and respect for international law and with the relevant provisions of the 1961 Vienna Convention that regulates Diplomatic Relations between States.

The Government of Malta and the Government of Grenada have decided to establish Diplomatic Relations at Ambassadorial level as from the date of the signing of this Protocol.

Both Parties have agreed that the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961 shall apply to diplomatic relations between them.
