JOINT COMMUNIQUE ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN SOLOMON ISLANDS AND THE REPUBLIC OF CAPE VERDE

Guided by the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations, as well as the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961 and the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of 24 April 1963,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.

In witness thereof, the undersigned representatives, duly mandated by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué in duplicate in Portuguese and English languages, the two texts being equally authentic.
