

**JOINT COMMUNIQUE
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF GEORGIA
AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO**

The Government of Georgia and the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago, guided by a shared willingness to develop ties of friendship and cooperation;

Both Governments reaffirming their commitment to the principles of the United Nations and of international law, including, the sovereign equality of States, territorial integrity, non-violability of State frontiers and non-interference in the internal affairs of another State;

Both Governments being fully convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations corresponds to the interests of both States and will further strengthen international peace and security;

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at the Ambassadorial level, on a non-residential basis, in conformity with the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961 as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.


Done in New York, on 8 April, 2011, in Georgian and English languages, both texts being equally authentic.
