QUESTION CONSIDERED BY THE FIRST EMERGENCY SPECIAL SESSION OF THE
GENERAL ASSEMBLY FROM 1 TO 10 NOVEMBER 1956

Letter dated 24 November 1956 from the Permanent
Representative of Israel to the United Nations, addressed
to the Secretary-General

New York, 24 November 1956

In the aide-memoire submitted to you on 21 November and included in
your report,^{1/} the Israel Government announced that there had been withdrawals
of its forces for varying lengths along the entire Egyptian front.

The question has been asked whether these withdrawals include any
substantial movements of Israel forces out of Egyptian territory back to
the Israel side of the Egypt-Israel frontier.

The answer is affirmative. Considerable bodies of Israel troops and
equipment which were in Sinai on 7 November are now back in Israel territory.
Figures will be published in due course.

I would appreciate the transmission of this information to the General
Assembly.
