**JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN MONGOLIA AND THE REPUBLIC OF MALAWI**

The Government of Mongolia and the Government of the Republic of Malawi,

Desirous of promoting and strengthening relations of friendship and cooperation in the political, economic, cultural, humanitarian and other mutual cooperation fields between their countries on the basis of equality and mutual respect for each other's sovereignty, independence and territorial integrity as well as non-interference in the internal affairs of each other;

Believing in development of these essential relations on the basis of the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations, and norms of international law;

Convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations corresponds with the national interests of both countries and will further strengthen international peace and security;

Have agreed to establish diplomatic relations as of the date of the signature of this Joint Communiqué, in accordance with the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18, 1961, Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of April 24, 1963 and relevant principles and norms of the United Nations Charter and international law;

Have further agreed to promote their bilateral dialogue through their diplomatic missions to the United Nations and other convenient diplomatic channels;

In witness thereof, the undersigned representatives, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué in New York on 21 December 2011 in two originals in Mongolian and English languages, both texts equally authentic.
