PROVISIONAL NET CONTRIBUTIONS PAYABLE IN 1961 BY MEMBER STATES

Note by the Secretary-General

1. Presented herewith for the information of Member States is a provisional statement (annex I) of the net contributions payable by Member States to the United Nations budget and to the United Nations Emergency Force Special Account for 1961, and to the Congo Ad Hoc Account for the period 14 July-31 December 1960.
2. A second provisional statement (annex II) shows the advances to the Working Capital Fund and contributions to the United Nations budget and to the United Nations Emergency Force Special Account for 1960 payable by the new Members admitted to the Organization during the fifteenth session of the General Assembly.
3. The amounts indicated for each Member State are based on the recommended scale of assessments of Members and the total appropriations recommended to the General Assembly by the Fifth Committee after applying the credits to which each Member is entitled under relevant financial regulations. They do not, however, take into account the reductions that would be applied pursuant to resolution (XV)(UNEF)^{1/} and resolution (XV)(ONUC),^{2/} at the request of the Member States concerned.
4. Final statements showing the gross and net assessments and the credits for each Member State will be issued as soon as possible after the General Assembly has taken final action on the recommendations of the Fifth Committee.
