LETTER DATED 10 JANUARY 1952 ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL BY THE SECRETAR OF STATE FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF THE FRENCH REFUBLIC

Paris, 10 January 1952

In my letter No. 162 of 22 December 1951 I informed you of the decision adopted by the French Government in collaboration with the British authorities to transfer to the Libyan Government as from 24 December 1951 the powers still exercised by France as the Power administering the Fezzan.

With reference to that communication I have the honcur to send you herewith the text of proclamations Nos. 3 and 42^{-1} , dated 15 and 24 December respectively, issued by the French Resident in the Fezzan.

These texts might be included as Annexes Nos. 15 and 16 to the Report on the administration of the Fezzan which I addressed to you in my letter No. 148 of 20 November and which has since been distributed as a United Nations document (A/1970).

Letter dated 22 December 1951 addressed to the Secretary-General, by the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs of the French Republic

Paris, 22 December 1952

I have the honour to inform you that the French Government has decided, in collaboration with the British authorities, to transfer to the Libyan Government as from 24 December 1951 the powers still exercised by France as Administering Power in the Fezzan.

These measures, which are additional to the provisions already adopted by France, will implement the resolutions on Libya adopted on 21 November 1949 and 17 November 1950 by the General Assembly of the United Nations.
