ORGANIZATION OF WORK

Note by the secretariat

1. The secretariat has prepared the proposed organization of work for the twenty-eighth session of the Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia (ESCWA) to facilitate the consideration of the agenda items within the time limitations. The Commission will be presented with the proposed organization of work contained in the present document and shall adopt it in that or an amended form.

2. The session convenes its inaugural meeting at 10 a.m. on Monday, 15 September 2014. The meetings of the senior officials segment shall start at 10.15 a.m. Two meetings will be held, one in the morning and one in the afternoon on Monday and Tuesday, 15 and 16 September 2014, according to the annexed organization of work. The senior officials segment will end at 4.15 p.m. on Tuesday after agreeing on the recommendations and resolutions to be submitted to the ministerial segment for adoption.

3. The ministerial segment of the session will convene its inaugural meeting at 9.30 a.m. on Wednesday, 17 September 2014, and will start the debate on the main theme of the session "Social justice in the policies of Arab States" at 11 a.m. Those discussions will be conducted in four meetings, one in the morning and one in the afternoon, on Wednesday and Thursday, 17 and 18 September 2014. The twenty-eighth session of the Commission will conclude its proceedings at 4.30 p.m. on Thursday, 18 September 2014, with the adoption of a ministerial declaration on social justice in the policies of Arab States, and the adoption of the report of the commission on its twenty-eighth session which includes the recommendations and resolutions.

4. Each presentation made by the secretariat will last for 10-15 minutes and the related discussion for 20-45 minutes. Should the discussion of one item be completed before the specified time, the meeting will move on to the next item.
