**LETTER DATED 30 OCTOBER 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL**

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to report the following Iraqi violations of the terms of cease-fire.

1. On 27 September 1991, several Iraqi soldiers were observed in no man's land around the geographical coordinates of 430-660 on the map of Naft Shahr.
2. On 28 September 1991, two Iraqi patrol guards attempted to infiltrate the Khosravi border post at the geographical coordinates of 43-05 on the map of Khosravi inside the territory of the Islamic Republic of Iran. Following the reaction of the Iranian border guards the Iraqi soldiers retreated into Iraq.
3. On 28 September 1991, 15 Iraqi soldiers were observed engaged in military exercises in no man's land at the geographical coordinates of 56-41 on the map of Hoor.
4. On 30 September 1991, a number of anti-revolutionary elements dispatched from Iraq attempted to infiltrate the position of Iranian forces during the night at the geographical coordinates of 454-071 on the map of Khosravi. Following the reaction of the Iranian forces they retreated into Iraq.
5. On 30 September 1991, at 2030 and 2200 hours, anti-revolutionary elements dispatched from Iraq created a confrontation with Iranian border guards around the geographical coordinates of 975-418 on the map of Marivan.
6. On 3 October 1991, at 1500 hours, an Iraqi loader was observed constructing an embankment in no man's land around the geographical coordinates of 291-821 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar.
7. On 4 October 1991, at 2230 hours, an Iraqi helicopter violated Iranian airspace and landed at Hoveizeh. The occupants of the

helicopter contacted two anti-revolutionary elements on the spot and, following the intervention of the Iranian forces, the helicopter flew away to Iraq.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter was circulated as a document of the Security Council.
