NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON CAMBODIA

1. On 23 October 1991, the Paris Conference on Cambodia adopted the following instruments:

(a) Final Act of the Paris Conference on Cambodia;

(b) Agreement on a Comprehensive Political Settlement of the Cambodia Conflict, with annexes on the mandate for the United Nations Transitional Authority in Cambodia, military matters, elections, repatriation of Cambodian refugees and displaced persons, and the principles for a new Cambodian constitution;

(c) Agreement Concerning the Sovereignty, Independence, Territorial Integrity and Inviolability, Neutrality and National Unity of Cambodia;

(d) Declaration on the Rehabilitation and Reconstruction of Cambodia.

2. By a letter dated 30 October 1991, the Permanent Representative of France to the United Nations and the Chargé d'Affaires a.i. of the Permanent Mission of Indonesia to the United Nations, on behalf of the Co-Presidents of the Paris Conference on Cambodia, requested circulation of these instruments (S/23177).

3. In accordance with the request addressed to me in paragraph 12 of the Final Act of the Paris Conference, I am hereby drawing the attention of the Security Council to this matter, in order to enable it to consider the comprehensive political settlement of the Cambodia conflict at the earliest opportunity.
