The Government of the Republic of Seychelles and the Government of Solomon Islands, guided by a shared willingness to develop ties of friendship and cooperation in the political, economic, cultural, and other fields, have decided to establish relations.

The Government of the Republic of Seychelles and the Government of Solomon Islands hereby agree to the establishment of diplomatic relations between their two countries as of the date of this Note based on the Vienna Convention on the Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961 and on the principles and norms of the Charter of the United Nations and of international law.

The Government of the Republic of Seychelles and the Government of Solomon Islands are fully convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations corresponds to the interests of both States and will further strengthen international peace and security.




