Letter dated 16 November 1971 from the Permanent Representative of Uganda to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I refer to my Government's letter of 9 February 1971 in which you were informed of Uganda's national candidate for election to the International Law Commission. My Government has decided in the interest of African unity, to withdraw the candidature of the Hon. P.J. Nkambo Mugerwa, the Attorney General of Uganda, in favour of the other five African candidates.
