JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ

ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF SURINAME AND THE KINGDOM OF SWAZILAND

The Government of the Republic of Suriname and the Government of the Kingdom of Swaziland,

Desiring to promote mutual understanding and strengthen friendship and cooperation between the States;

Guided by the principles of international law and the goals and objectives of the Charter of the United Nations, particularly in regard to the promotion of international peace and security, respect for equality among States, national sovereignty, independence, territorial integrity, non-interference in the internal affairs of the States and adherence to international treaties;

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations between the Republic of Suriname and the Kingdom of Swaziland, in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961, as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.

In witness thereof, the undersigned representatives, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué in duplicate in the English language.
