JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ

ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN

THE REPUBLIC OF MOZAMBIQUE AND THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS

The Republic of Mozambique and the Republic of Belarus, desiring to promote mutual understanding and strengthen the friendship and cooperation between their two peoples and states in the political, economic, social, humanitarian and other fields, have decided to establish diplomatic relations as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.

The two countries agreed to establish their diplomatic relations in accordance with the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18, 1961 and relevant principles, purposes and norms of the Charter of the United Nations and international law.

The Republic of Mozambique and the Republic of Belarus are fully convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations corresponds to the interests of both States and will further strengthen international peace and security.

In witness thereof, the undersigned representatives, duly authorized by their respective States, have signed this Joint Communiqué in triplicate, in Portuguese, Belarusian and English, all texts being equally authentic.
