SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF
WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE
REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATIONAddendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/18570 of 8 January 1987.

During the week ending 28 March 1987, pursuant to a note by the Secretary-General dated 23 March 1987 (S/18760), the Security Council met at its 2739th meeting, on 27 March 1987, to consider the date of an election to fill a vacancy in the International Court of Justice as a result of the death of Judge Guy Ladreit de Lacharrière.

The President called attention to the text of a draft resolution contained in document S/18761 that had been prepared in the course of consultations.

The Security Council voted on the draft resolution (S/18761) and adopted it unanimously as resolution 595 (1987).

Resolution 595 (1987) reads as follows:

The Security Council,

Noting with regret the death of Judge Guy Ladreit de Lacharrière on 10 March 1987,

Noting further that a vacancy in the International Court of Justice for the remainder of the term of office of the deceased judge has thus occurred and must be filled in accordance with the terms of the Statute of the Court,

Noting that, in accordance with Article 14 of the Statute, the date of the election to fill this vacancy shall be fixed by the Security Council,

Decides that the election to fill the vacancy shall take place on 14 September 1987 at a meeting of the Security Council and at a meeting of the forty-first session of the General Assembly.

During the same week, the Security Council took no action on any of the items listed in document S/18570.
