cooperation among their two peoples,


Guided by the principles and purposes of the United Nations Charter and other

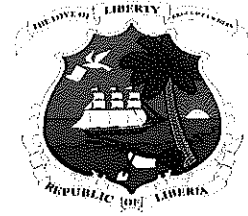
