

I want to attend this coming United Nations Trusteeship Council session but for lack of funds, I'm not sure to make the trip. I therefore request your assistance and advice for financial aid to cover my travel expenses.

It will be my last trip since the United States of America is tentatively going to terminate its United Nations Trusteeship Agreement by next year - 1981. Hence I want to make my last appeal to the members of the Trusteeship Council concerning the Angaur phosphate claims.

We waited for you and other members of the United Nations Visiting Mission to come to Angaur on your recent trip to Palau but we were unfortunate for the trip did not materialize. I hope there will be another United Nations Visiting Mission coming to Angaur as Angaur always weldomes such a trip.
