APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF SUBSIDIARY BODIES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

BOARD OF AUDITORS

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Babooram RAMBISSOON (Trinidad and Tobago)

- 1. At its 1437th meeting, held on 22 October 1971, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/8353) concerning the vacancy in the membership of the Board of Auditors which will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of one of its members on 30 June 1972.
- 2. The members of the Fifth Committee were invited to make suggestions in regard to the country whose Auditor-General (or officer holding the equivalent title) might be recommended to the General Assembly for appointment as a member of the Board of Auditors. The Government of Colombia proposed the Auditor-General of Colombia for re-election as a member of the Board of Auditors (see A/C.5/1374).
- 3. To decide on its recommendation to the General Assembly, the Committee voted by secret ballot. The result of the ballot was as follows:

4. The Auditor-General of Colombia, having received the required majority, was declared recommended for appointment as a member of the Board of Auditors, for a three-year term beginning on 1 July 1972.
