ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA OF THE TWENTY-SIXTH REGULAR SESSION AND ALLOCATION OF ITEMS

Fourth report of the General Committee

- 1. At its 196th meeting, on 18 November 1971, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Algeria, Botswana, Burundi, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Dahomey, Egypt, Equatorial Guinea, Ethiopia, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Ivory Coast, Kenya, Liberia, Libyan Arab Republic, Madagascar, Mali, Mauritania, Morocco, Niger, Nigeria, People's Republic of the Congo, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Sudan, Swaziland, Togo, Tunisia, Uganda, United Republic of Tanzania, Upper Volta, Zaire and Zambia (A/8494 and Corr.l and Add.l) for the inclusion in the agenda of the twenty-sixth session of an additional item entitled "Co-operation between the United Nations and the Organization of African Unity: holding of meetings of the Security Council in an African capital". 1/
- 2. The General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly:
 - (a) that the item should be placed on the agenda;
 - (b) that it should be considered in plenary session.
