

## JOINT COMMUNIQUE ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF KAZAKHSTAN AND THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

The Republic of Kazakhstan and the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago, guided by a shared willingness to develop ties of friendship and cooperation;

Both States reaffirming their commitment to the principles of the Charter of the United Nations and of international law, including the sovereign equality of States, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of another State:

Both States being fully convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations corresponds to the interests of both States and will further strengthen international peace and security;

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at the Ambassadorial level, on a non-residential basis, in conformity with the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961 as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.
