


We take this opportunity to renew to your Excellency the assurances of our highest consideration.



**JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ  
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS  
BETWEEN  
THE REPUBLIC OF LATVIA AND THE REPUBLIC OF THE CONGO**

The Government of the Republic of Latvia and the Government of the Republic of the Congo,

**Desirous** to strengthen the bonds of friendship and cooperation between their two countries, based on the principles of mutual respect of equality among States, sovereignty, political independence, international treaties, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of another State,

**Guided** by the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations, international law and the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18, 1961,

**Convinced** that the establishment of diplomatic relations corresponds to the national interests of both States and will consolidate the strengthening of international peace and cooperation,

**Have decided** to establish diplomatic relations as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.

In witness thereof, the undersigned representatives, duly authorised by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué in two originals in Latvian, French and English languages, all three texts being equally authentic.
