ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 30 September 1971 from the President of the
Security Council to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the General Assembly the following resolution^{1/} on the admission of Oman to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 1587th meeting, on 30 September 1971:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of Oman for admission to the United Nations, 2/

"Recommends to the General Assembly that Oman be admitted to membership in the United Nations".

I should like further to mention that the Security Council decided, following adoption of the resolution, to have recourse to the provisions of the final paragraph of rule 60 of its provisional rules of procedure in submitting its recommendation to the General Assembly.

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, I also request you to transmit to the General Assembly, for its information, the verbatim records of the 1574th and 1587th meetings of the Security Council, at which the application of Oman was discussed.
