Decree No. 8/1898 of the Council of Ministers

Pursuant to letters No. 11851 of 2 October 1980 and No. 13108 of 3 November 1980 of the Ministry of Health and Social Welfare, the Council of Ministers decided on 11 November 1980 that the substances sufentanil and dextroproxyphene should be made subject to the provisions of Act No. 2313 of 12 June 1933 concerning control of narcotic drugs, in accordance with article 19 of the above-mentioned act.
