Excellency,


We have the honor to inform you that as from today, 24 August 2000, diplomatic relations have been established between the Governments of the Republic of Macedonia and Saint Lucia.

Joint Communiqué
on the establishment of Diplomatic relations between
the Republic of Macedonia and Saint Lucia

The Government of the Republic of Macedonia and the Government of Saint Lucia, guided by mutual willingness to develop friendly relations and cooperation between the two States in political, trade, economic and other fields, have decided to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level with effect from the date of signature of the present Joint Communiqué.


The two countries have agreed to establish diplomatic relations based on the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18, 1961 and principles and norms of the Charter of the United Nations and International Law.

The Republic of Macedonia and Saint Lucia are fully convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations corresponds to the interests of both states and will further strengthen international peace and security.

In witness whereof, the undersigned Plenipotentiaries have signed this Joint Communiqué in English.
