

**JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN
THE REPUBLIC OF LATVIA AND THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF
TIMOR-LESTE**

The Republic of Latvia and the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste,

With the purpose to promote mutual understanding and strengthen the friendship and co-operation among their two peoples;

On the basis of the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations and international law, particularly on the basis of mutual respect of equality among States, sovereignty, political independence, international treaties, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of another State, as well as of promotion of international peace and security,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at ministerial level, in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961, as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.

In witness thereof, the undersigned representatives, duly authorised by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué in duplicate in Latvian and English languages, both texts being equally authentic.
