Please accept, Excellency, the assurances of our highest consideration.



The Government of the Republic of Botswana and the Government of Montenegro,

Desirous of promoting mutual understanding and strengthening the friendship and cooperation between the two countries,


Guided by the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations and international law, particularly on the respect for and promotion of international peace and security, equality among States, national sovereignty, independence, international treaties, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of States,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level, in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961, as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.


