**JOINT COMMUNIQUE ON THE ESTABLISHMENT
OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN
THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS AND THE REPUBLIC OF FIJI**

The Government of the Republic of Belarus and the Government of the Republic of Fiji,

Guided by their willingness to promote mutual understanding and strengthen friendship and cooperation between the two States in the political, economic, cultural and other areas in accordance with the principles and purposes of the United Nations Charter and the norms of international law;

Confirming adherence to the principles of equality among States, national sovereignty, independence, territorial integrity, inviolability of borders and non-interference in the internal affairs of States;

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at the ambassadorial level in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18, 1961, as of the date of signing of this Joint Communiqué.

In witness thereof, the undersigned representatives, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed in duplicate this Joint Communiqué in the Belarusian and English languages, both texts being equally authentic.
