The Independent State of Samoa and Georgia,

Desirous of promoting mutual understanding and strengthening the friendship and cooperation among their two peoples,

Guided by the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations and international law, particularly the respect for and promotion of international peace and security, equality among States, national sovereignty, independence, international treaties, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of States,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level, in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961, with effect from the date of signing of this Joint Communiqué.

**IN WITNESS THEREOF**, the undersigned Representatives, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué in duplicate in Samoan, Georgian and English languages.

Done in New York on the 12 day of the month of March of the year two thousand and ten.


