The Government of Georgia and The Government of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam, guided by mutual willingness to develop relations of friendship and cooperation between the two States in the political, economic, cultural and any other field on the basis of common agreement,

Convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations between them is in the interests of both States and will facilitate the strengthening of international cooperation and universal peace,

Guided by the principles enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations and other fundamental norms and principles of international law, particularly, equality among States, respect for national sovereignty, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of another State,

Have agreed to establish diplomatic relations in accordance with the Provisions of the 1961 Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations at Ambassadorial level as from the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.

Done in New York, on March 1, 2010, in English and Georgian languages, both texts being equally authentic. In case of divergence in interpretation of this Joint Communiqué, the English text shall prevail.
