Union of Soviet Socialist Republics: draft resolution

The General Assembly

Condemns the "Mutual Security Act of 1951" adopted in the United States of
America providing for the appropriation of funds for subversive activities against
certain States, as an act of aggression and as interference in the internal
affairs of other States, in contravention of the principles of the United Nations
Charter and of the generally-acknowledged rules of international law; and

Recommends the Government of the United States of America to take the
necessary steps to repeal this Act.
