Gabon\*: amendments to the draft resolution contained in document A/46/23 (Part IV), chapter VI, paragraph 18

1. Page 7: replace the fifteenth preambular paragraph by the following text

Noting with serious concern the continuing effects of the acts of aggression and destabilization that have been committed by South Africa against neighbouring independent African States,

2. Page 7: replace the eighteenth preambular paragraph by the following text

Gravely concerned that while the international community has generally adhered to the Programme of Action contained in the Declaration on Apartheid and its Destructive Consequences in Southern Africa, some Member States have continued relations with South Africa in the political, diplomatic, economic and other fields,

3. Fage 10: replace paragraph 19 by the following text

19. <u>Urges</u> all States, especially those that continue to have economic and financial links to South Africa, to adhere fully to the Programme of Action contained in the Declaration on Apartheid and its Destructive Consequences in Southern Africa.
