1. The CHAIRMAN informed the Committee that, despite his appeal at the previous meeting, there were no speakers on the question before the Committee. That was a regrettable situation from the point of view of the work of that session of the General Assembly, and was difficult to explain since the question had been before the Committee for some ten days, during which period delegations had had ample time to prepare their statements. Moreover, the main aspects of the question were known, since it had been discussed by the General Assembly at its previous session. In the circumstances the only possible course would be to close the list of speakers, and he proposed to do this following the next meeting which would be held on Monday, 12 October 1953 at 3 p.m.
