Georgia and the Republic of Kenya, hereinafter referred to as the Parties,

Guided by mutual willingness to develop relations of friendship and cooperation between the two States in political, economic, cultural and other fields,

Convinced that the establishment of diplomatic and consular relations between Georgia and the Republic of Kenya corresponds to the interests of the parties, and will facilitate the strengthening of international cooperation and universal peace,

Guided by the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations and International Law as well as the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 1961 and the Vienna Convention on Consular relations of 1963,

Desiring to develop relations between the parties on the basis of the principles of sovereign equality, cooperation and friendly relations among States, territorial integrity, inviolability of frontiers of sovereign States and non-interference in the internal affairs of other States,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level, and to establish consular relations as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.

Done in New York on this July, day of 2, 2010 in the Georgian and English languages, all texts being equally authentic.

**JOINT COMMUNIQUE

The Republic of Kenya and Georgia, hereinafter referred to as the Parties,
