Observance of the ceasefire regime

Monitoring groups have continued to monitor observance of the ceasefire regime as part of implementing the Memorandum on the creation of de-escalation areas in the Syrian Arab Republic signed by the Russian Federation, the Republic of Turkey and the Islamic Republic of Iran on 4 May 2017.

The situation in the de-escalation areas has been assessed as stable.

The Russian representative office of the Russian and Turkish Joint Commission reviewing issues related to violations of the ceasefire regime has reported 11 incidents of gunfire in the following Governorates: five in Aleppo, three in Homs, two in Ladhqiyyah and one in Damascus.

The Turkish representative office has reported three violations in the following Governorates: two in Aleppo and one in Damascus.

Most incidents of small arms being fired indiscriminately have been reported in areas controlled by fighters of the terrorist groups Nusrah Front and the Islamic State in Iraq and the Levant (ISIL).

Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic

The Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides in the Syrian Arab Republic carried out no humanitarian operations over the past 24 hours.

In total, 1,674 humanitarian operations have been carried out, with a total weight of 2,287.3 tons.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to two residents.

In total, medical assistance has been provided to 63,777 residents.

Reconciliation of opposing sides

Over the past 24 hours, one ceasefire regime agreement was signed with Tall Amiri in Homs Governorate.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process has increased to 2,266.

Negotiations on joining the ceasefire regime continued with armed opposition groups in Aleppo, Hama, Homs, Damascus and Qunaytirah Governorates.

The number of armed groups that have announced their commitment to accepting and fulfilling the terms of the ceasefire is unchanged — it is still 234.

Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic

Over the past 24 hours, the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides in the Syrian Arab Republic has carried out one humanitarian operation in Ba'th in Qunaytirah Governorate; humanitarian packages with a total weight of 1.5 tons were delivered to the local population.

In total, 1,675 humanitarian operations have been carried out, with a total weight of 2288.8 tons.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 101 residents.

In total, medical assistance has been provided to 63,878 residents.

Reconciliation of opposing sides

Over the past 24 hours, one ceasefire agreement was signed with Aqarib al-Safi in Hama Governorate.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process has increased to 2,267.

Negotiations on joining the ceasefire regime continued with armed opposition groups in Aleppo, Hama, Homs, Damascus and Qunaytirah Governorates.

The number of armed groups that have announced their commitment to accepting and fulfilling the terms of the ceasefire is unchanged — it is still 234.

In total, 1,676 humanitarian operations have been carried out, with a total weight of 2,290.7 tons.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 226 residents.

In total, medical assistance has been provided to 64,104 residents.

One humanitarian convoy was sent through the United Nations to Duma in Damascus Governorate; food and medicines with a total weight of 129 tons were delivered to the local population.

Reconciliation of opposing sides

No ceasefire regime agreements were signed over the past 24 hours.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process remains unchanged at 2,267.

Negotiations on joining the ceasefire regime continued with armed opposition groups in Aleppo, Hama, Homs, Damascus and Qunaytirah Governorates.

The number of armed groups that have announced their commitment to accepting and fulfilling the terms of the ceasefire is unchanged — it is still 234.

Over the past 24 hours, two ceasefire regime agreements were signed with Tannunah, in Homs Governorate, and Muflisah, in Aleppo Governorate.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process has increased to 2,269.

Negotiations on joining the ceasefire regime continued with armed opposition groups in Aleppo, Damascus, Hama, Homs and Qunaytirah Governorates.

The number of armed groups that have announced their commitment to accepting and fulfilling the terms of the ceasefire is unchanged — it is still 234.
