JOINT COMMUNIQUE
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN
THE REPUBLIC OF KENYA
AND
THE REPUBLIC OF PARAGUAY

The Republic of Kenya and the Republic of Paraguay;

Guided by the mutual desire to strengthen the existing friendly relations between the two States in political, economic, commercial, cultural and other fields;

Based on the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations and international law, particularly equality among States, respect for independence, national sovereignty, territorial integrity, and non-interference in the internal affairs of States;

Have decided to establish Diplomatic relations on the basis of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961, and Consular relations as provided in the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of 1963.

This Agreement shall come into force upon signature.

Done in New York, on September 25th, 2009 in duplicate, in English and Spanish languages, being all texts equally authentic.

COMUNICADO CONJUNTO
SOBRE EL ESTABLECIMIENTO DE RELACIONES DIPLOMÁTICAS

La República del Paraguay y la República de Kenya;

Guiadas por el mutuo deseo de fortalecer las existentes relaciones de amistad entre los dos Estados en lo político, económico, comercial, cultural y otras áreas;

Con la intención de basar esta relación en los principios y normas de la Carta de las Naciones Unidas y del Derecho Internacional, particularmente la igualdad entre los Estados, el respeto por la independencia, la soberanía nacional, la integridad territorial y la no injerencia en los asuntos internos de los Estados;

Han decidido establecer Relaciones Diplomáticas de conformidad con la Convención de Viena sobre Relaciones Diplomáticas del 18 de abril de 1961, y asimismo Relaciones Consulares de acuerdo a la Convención de Viena de 1963 sobre Relaciones Consulares.

El presente Acuerdo entrará en vigor a la fecha de su firma.

Firmado en la ciudad de Nueva York, el día 25 de Septiembre de 2009 en duplicado, en los idiomas español, e inglés, siendo todos los textos igualmente auténticos.
