

JOINT COMMUNIQUE

ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN AUSTRALIA AND THE REPUBLIC OF EQUATORIAL GUINEA

The Government of Australia and the Government of the Republic of Equatorial Guinea;

With the purpose of promoting mutual understanding and strengthening the friendship and cooperation among their two peoples in political, economic, social, humanitarian and other fields, in accordance with the principles and norms enshrined in international law, including the Charter of the United Nations and the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations dated 18 April 1961;

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.

The Governments of Australia and the Republic of Equatorial Guinea wish to express their mutual confidence that establishing diplomatic relations corresponds to the interests of both States and will help to consolidate international peace and security as well as peaceful co-existence, particularly mutual respect of national sovereignty, independence, territorial integrity and non interference in the internal affairs of states.

In witness whereof, the undersigned Representatives, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué in two identical originals, in English and Spanish, both texts being equally authentic.



COMUNICADO CONJUNTO

SOBRE EL ESTABLECIMIENTO DE RELACIONES DIPLOMATICAS ENTRE AUSTRALIA Y LA REPUBLICA DE GUINEA ECUATORIAL

El Gobierno de Australia y el Gobierno de la República de Guinea Ecuatorial;

Con el propósito de promover el entendimiento y estrechar la amistad y la cooperación entre los dos países en los aspectos político, económico, social, humanitario y otros campos de acuerdo con los principios y objetivos de la Carta de las Naciones Unidas, el Derecho Internacional y la Convención de Viena sobre Relaciones Diplomáticas del 18 de abril de 1961;

Han decidido establecer relaciones diplomáticas, a partir de la fecha de la firma del presente Comunicado Conjunto;

El Gobierno de Australia y el de la República de Guinea Ecuatorial desean expresar su mutua confianza que el establecimiento de las Relaciones Diplomáticas corresponden a los intereses de ambos Estados y favorecerá a consolidar la paz y la seguridad internacionales, así como la coexistencia pacífica, particularmente, en el respeto mutuo de la soberanía nacional, la independencia, la integridad territorial y la no injerencia en los asuntos internos de los Estados;

En fe de lo cual, los abajo firmantes Representantes, debidamente autorizados por sus respectivos Gobiernos, han firmado el presente Comunicado Conjunto en dos ejemplares originales, inglés y español, siendo ambos textos igualmente auténticos.
