Born at Salonica in 1905.

Law degree from the University of Paris, 1926; Doctor of Political Science of the Faculty of Law of Paris, 1928; obtained a degree from the Faculty of Law of Ankara and from the School of Political Science of Paris.

Director of the Cabinet of the Ministry of Justice, 1929; Judge, Inspector General of Justice, 1931-1934; Director-General of Civil Affairs, 1934-1937; member of the National Assembly, 1938-1948; Rapporteur of the Commission of Justice at the National Assembly, 1939-1946; Minister of Justice, September 1946 - June 1948; Turkish delegate to the Hague Conference for the Codification of International Law, 1930; member of the Turkish-Netherlands Arbitral Commission; delegate of Turkey at the Congress of International Penal Law; adviser to the Turkish delegation to the United Nations Conference on International Organization in San Francisco; representative of Turkey to the third session of the General Assembly of the United Nations.
