Identical letters dated 28 November 2017 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Permanent Mission of the Syrian Arab Republic to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General and the President of the Security Council

Upon instruction from my Government, I have the honour to submit herewith two tables clarifying the number of civilians killed and injured as a result of terrorist attacks, including those involving mortar shells and explosive devices, committed or launched by armed terrorist groups against safe neighbourhoods in different Syrian cities and areas, during the periods shown below.
