JOINT COMMUNIOUÉ BETWEEN

THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS

THE FEDERAL DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF NEPAL AND THE REPUBLIC OF BOTSWANA

Guided by the mutual desire to strengthen the existing friendly relations between the two States in political, cultural, commercial and other fields;

With the intent to base this relation on the principles and norms of the Charter of the United Nations and international law, particularly on equality among States, respect for independence, national sovereignty, territorial integrity, and non-interference in the internal affairs of States:

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations on the basis of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961, at the level of Ambassadors.

This Joint Communiqué shall come into force upon signature.
