- (b) RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE APPLICATION OF THE CONVENTION IN FUTURE ACTIVITIES OF INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS

Report of the Sixth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Eike BRACKLO (Federal Republic of Germany)

1. Pursuant to rule 13 (g) of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the Secretary-General proposed the inclusion in the agenda of the thirtieth regular session of the General Assembly of an item entitled:

"Resolutions adopted by the United Nations Conference on the Representation of States in Their Relations with International Organizations:

- "(a) Resolution relating to the observer status of national liberation movements recognized by the Organization of African Unity and/or by the League of Arab States;
- "(b) Resolution relating to the application of the Convention in future activities of international organizations" (A/10141).

2. At its 2353rd plenary meeting, on 19 September 1975, the General Assembly included the item in the agenda of its thirtieth session and decided to allocate it to the Sixth Committee.

3. The resolutions referred to above were adopted by the United Nations Conference on the Representation of States in Their Relations with International Organizations held in Vienna, at the invitation of the Federal Government of the Republic of Austria, from 4 February to 14 March 1975. Annexed to the Final Act of the Conference, $\underline{1}$ / both resolutions contained requests for consideration by the General Assembly.

4. At its 1581st meeting, on 4 December 1975, the Committee agreed that, because of the lack of time, consideration of the item should be deferred until the thirty-first session of the General Assembly.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE SIXTH COMMITTEE

5. The Sixth Committee recommends to the General Assembly that the item entitled:

"Resolutions adopted by the United Nations Conference on the Representation of States in Their Relations with International Organizations:

- "(a) Resolution relating to the observer status of national liberation movements recognized by the Organization of African Unity and/or by the League of Arab States;
- "(b) Resolution relating to the application of the Convention in future activities of international organizations"

should be included in the provisional agenda of its thirty-first session.
