Annotations

1. Election of officers

Rule 15 of the rules of procedure of the functional commissions of the Economic and Social Council stipulates that, at the commencement of the first meeting of a regular session, the Commission shall elect from among the representatives of its members a Chair, one or more Vice-Chairs and such other officers as may be required. In subparagraph (c) of its decision 2002/210, the Economic and Social Council decided that, immediately following the closure of a regular session, the Commission for Social Development would hold the first meeting of its subsequent regular session for the sole purpose of electing the new Chair and other members of the Bureau. In its resolution 2016/6, the Council reaffirmed that the officers elected to the Bureau of the Commission would continue to be elected for a term of office of two years, in parallel with the 2017–2018 review and policy cycle. Accordingly, the Commission held the first meeting of its fifty-sixth session on 10 February 2017, immediately following the closure of the fifty-fifth session, and elected by acclamation Bruno Ríos Sánchez (Mexico) and Yao Shaojun (China) as Vice-Chairs of the fifty-sixth session. At the same meeting, the Commission postponed the election of the Chair from the Western European and other States and the Vice-Chair from the African States.

Subsequently, the Western European and other States nominated Nikulás Hannigan (Iceland) as Chair, the African States nominated Lot Dzonzi (Malawi) as Vice-Chair and the Eastern European States nominated Mihaela Mecea (Romania) as Vice-Chair of the Commission at its fifty-sixth session.

On 29 January 2018, the Commission will be invited to elect the Chair from the Western European and other States and Vice-Chairs from the African States and the Eastern European States, and to designate one of its Vice-Chairs as Rapporteur.

2. Adoption of the agenda and other organizational matters

Rule 7 of the rules of procedure requires that, after the election of its officers at the beginning of each session, the Commission shall adopt the agenda for that session on the basis of the provisional agenda. The provisional agenda and documentation for the fifty-sixth session of the Commission were approved by the Economic and Social Council in its decision 2017/231.

The proposed organization of work of the Commission at its fifty-sixth session (see annex I) has been prepared pursuant to relevant decisions of the General Assembly and the Economic and Social Council to facilitate the consideration of agenda items within the time frame available and in accordance with the conference services allocated to the Commission. The timetable should be considered tentative and indicative: if the Commission completes its consideration of an item ahead of schedule, it may wish to proceed immediately to the next item.

The Commission is scheduled to meet from Monday, 29 January, to Wednesday, 7 February 2018. Arrangements have been made to hold morning and afternoon meetings during the session: morning meetings will be held from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and afternoon meetings from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.
