Excellency,



**JOINT COMMUNIQUE'**

**On the establishment of Diplomatic Relations between  
The Republic of Liberia  
And  
Saint Vincent and the Grenadines**

The Government of the Republic of Liberia and the Government of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines;

Guided by their mutual willingness to develop and strengthen friendship and cooperation between the two States in political, economic, social, humanitarian and other fields, in accordance with the principles and norms enshrined in the charter of the United Nations, International Law and the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations dated 18 April 1961,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communique'

The Government of the Republic of Liberia and the Government of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines wish to express their mutual confidence that establishing diplomatic relations corresponds to the interest of both States and will help to consolidate international peace and security as well as peaceful co-existence.

In witness whereof, the undersigned Representatives, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communique' in duplicate.


